Why native Minnesota plants?

Native plants are beautiful, and provide food and shelter for wildlife including butterflies, dragonflies, pollinators and birds! Once established, plants native to this region are low maintenance and do not require care typically associated with gardens

Matching species to locations

It is important to match native plants with conditions where they can be most successful, so for your convenience the order form is organized by soil type,

light and moisture conditions.

Site preparation

You can start now! Proper site preparation gives your plants a great head start. Removal of competitive weeds and grasses must be accomplished before planting begins. One option: cover the area with 10-15 layers of newspapers to block out sunlight. Saturate the newspaper with water to prevent it from blowing away, then apply a clean mulch such as wood chips, pine bark or composted manure. Later, after the newspaper has softened, punch holes in it and insert your new plants.
