The North Carolina Division of Coastal Management (DCM) and the North Carolina National Estuarine Research Reserve's Coastal Training Program cordially invite you to attend the upcoming "Estuarine Shoreline Mapping (ESM) Summit," a workshop to coordinate estuarine shoreline mapping efforts in North Carolina. The ESM Summit's purpose is to discuss existing and future shoreline mapping initiatives and collaborate on methodology, resources, efforts, and needs.



As part of its 5-year strategic plan, DCM intends to delineate the estuarine shoreline and its associated shoreline type, and conduct a shoreline structure inventory. Such a comprehensive mapping effort has never been accomplished for North Carolina. This summit seeks to bring together mapping staff as well as agency managers and directors. The gathering will take place **December 4th and 5th** at the NOAA Beaufort Lab, Beaufort, NC.
